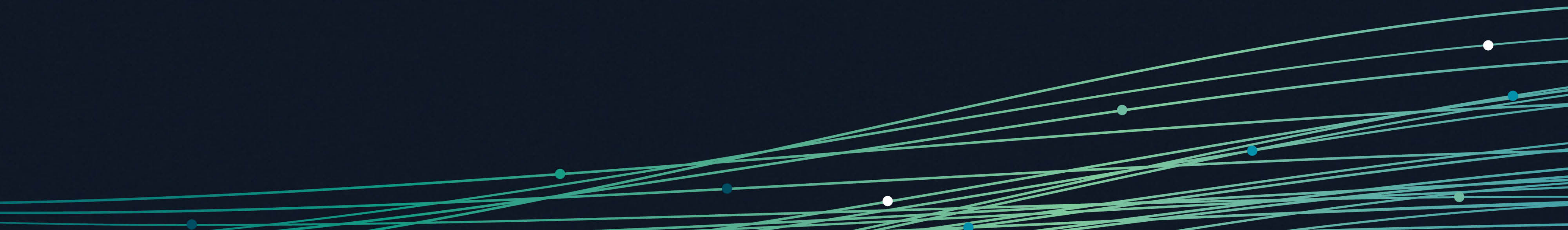

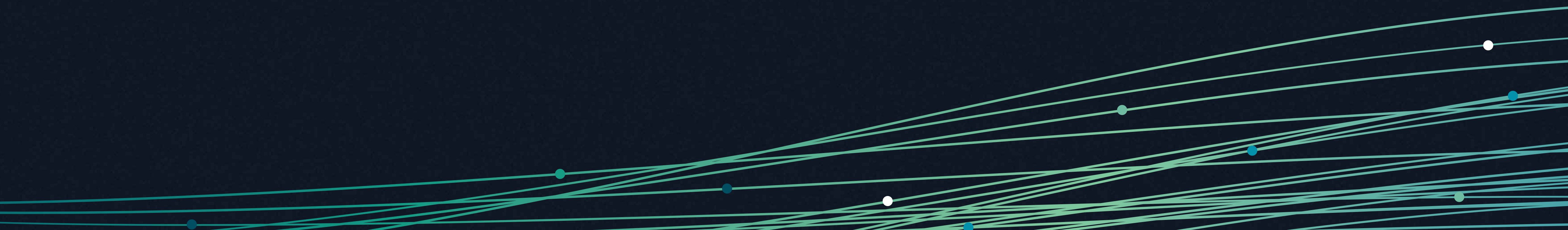

1 CORINTHIANS 9:23





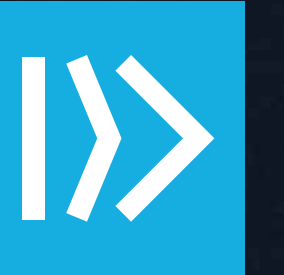

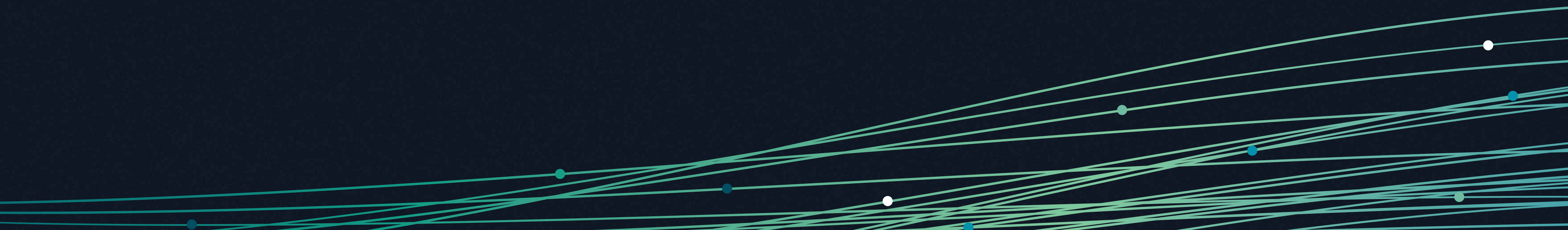

1 CORINTHIANS 9:19-20

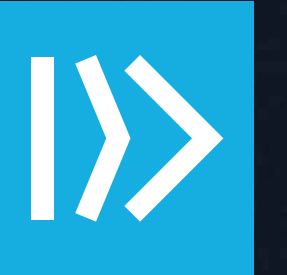




PRINCIPLE

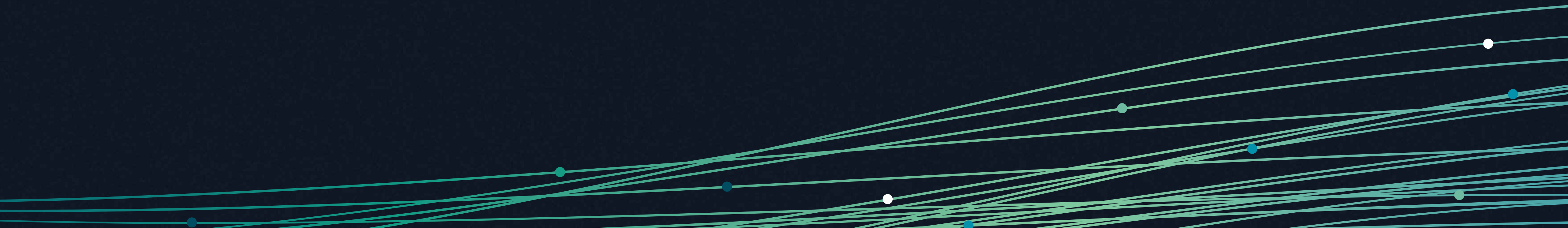
We are faithful to the gospel, while flexible with our culture. My culture is to orbit around the gospel, and not the gospel around my culture.

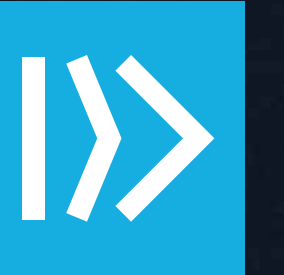

C2s are made, not born.

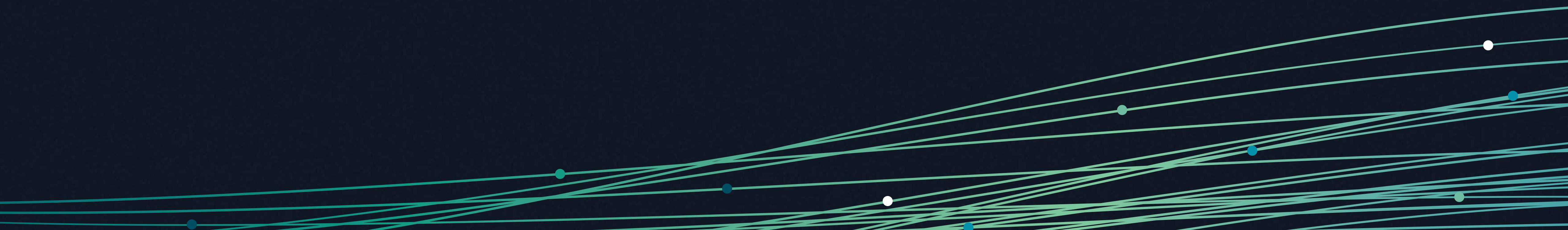
