## Covocational

“Co” comes from the latin prefix “com” meaning to have in common.

Think of words like:

“co-laborer”

“co-pilot”

“co-author”





## Bivo

*A Bivocational Church Planter* is someone who works a second job to supplement the salary the church provides. Their hope is that the church will eventually grow enough so they can leave their part-time job to focus full time on the church.





## Covo

A *Covocational Church Planter* is someone who has a clear calling in the marketplace that they *never* intend to leave. They know God has called them to be a school teacher, mechanic, graphic designer, engineer or business owner and at the same time they believe God is calling them to plant a church.
